

# GENERAL BUSINESS MINOR

(FOR STUDENTS OUTSIDE THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS)

The general business minor is available for students who are pursuing a major outside the College of Business. The 21 credits of courses listed below are required for the minor. At least 6 of these credits must have a grade of C or better, at least 6 credits of the 300 level courses must be taken at ISU, and 9 of these 21 credits must not be used to meet any other department, college, or university requirements. Please see below for the eligibility requirements to declare the general business minor.

- 3) A minimum ISU cumulative GPA of 2.5, or a minimum 2.5 GPA in the foundation courses.
