**Business Major: (18 – 21 credits)**

Required credits depend on the Major – To be taken at Iowa State University

*MIS majors: One or more of the following courses are strongly recommended for MIS majors: CIS C++, CIS 172 Java, or Cobol*

*Take @ ISU* *Stat 326 ( required for Acct, Fin, and Business Econ majors only)*

**Special Notes:**

1. All new entering students are enrolled in a pre-business curriculum. To enter the Professional Program and declare a Business major, students must complete the following: All Foundation Courses and English through ENGL 250 (including any Engl 101 requirements); completion of 30 credits; a minimum GPA of 2.5 in the foundation courses (using transfer grades) *or* in the cumulative ISU GPA.
2. MAT 211 AND 217 (Calc I & II) will substitute for Math 151 and 150, respectively. **Business Econ majors:** Math 160 and Econ 207 are required in lieu of Math 150 and 151; however these calculus courses can be used to substitute for them.
3. Effective Spring 2006, Statistics 226 is required of all business majors. Math 125T substitution has been approved for MKT, MGMT, MIS, OSCM or LSCM majors. However Stat 226 is required for ACCT, BUSEC and FIN majors.
4. The University requires all students in the 2007-2009 catalog take one course in both U.S. Diversity (3 cr.) and International Perspectives (3 cr.) Courses in these two areas can be used to meet **one** other Gen Ed requirement. 5. The College of Business does not include 300-level courses transferred from two-year institutions in the 42 credits of 300+ level needed to graduate from ISU.
6. The College of Business only allows a grade of Pass/Not Pass (P/NP) in non-business general electives.
7. ISU will accept up to 16 semester (24 quarter) hours of credit earned in vocational-technical courses when the sending community college has accepted such courses toward granting an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree.
8. No more than 65 semester credits earned at two-year Colleges can be applied to a bachelor's degree from Iowa State University.
9. A student's last 32 semester credits must be completed at Iowa State University.
